

## Technical Practice Chapter 1 [Quick Mask] function

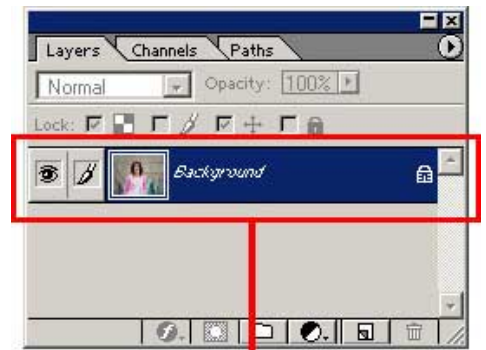
You can use pen tablets to effortlessly combine portraits and landscapes.

### STEP1

1.) Click the [Quick Mask] button.

the layer palett color changes into gray.

2.) Double-click the Quick Mask button. to display the [Quick Mask Options] window.

By setting the option to [Selected Area], the area you want to select is covered into the mask area.



Dobule-click to display the option window.

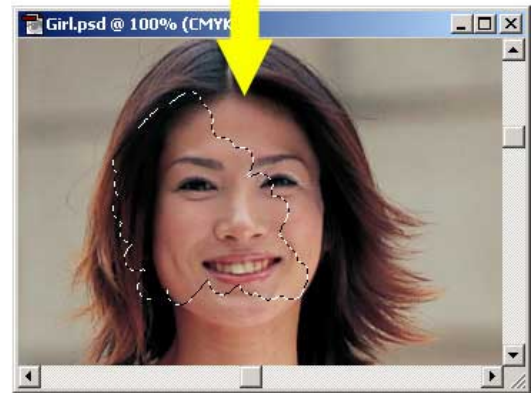
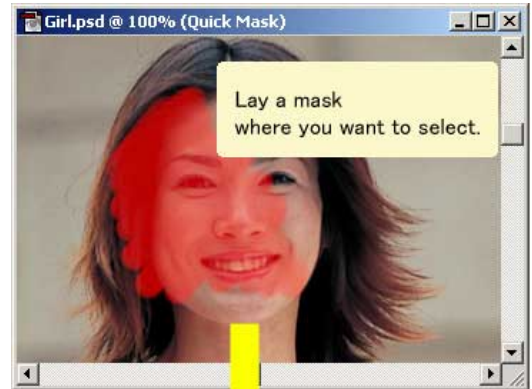
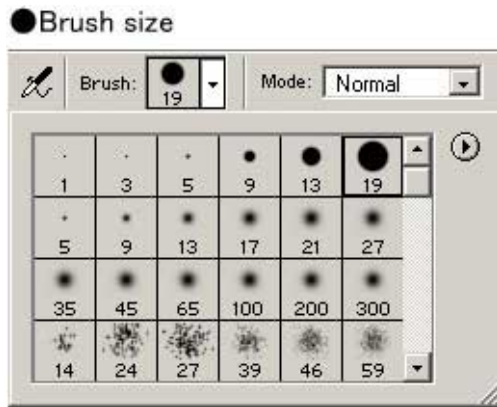

You don't need to apply this establishment once you do.

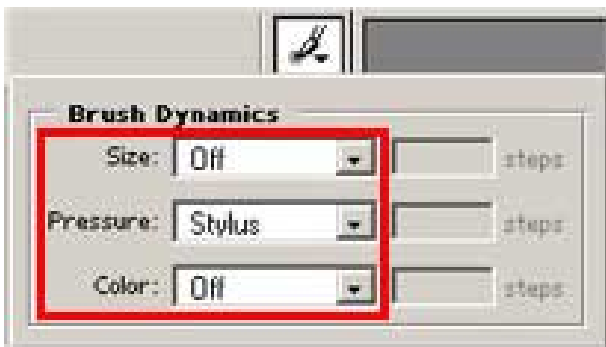
## STEP2

- 1.) To select a brush tool and set the color to black. Place a check mark next to the [Size-Opacity] field in the brush tool options.



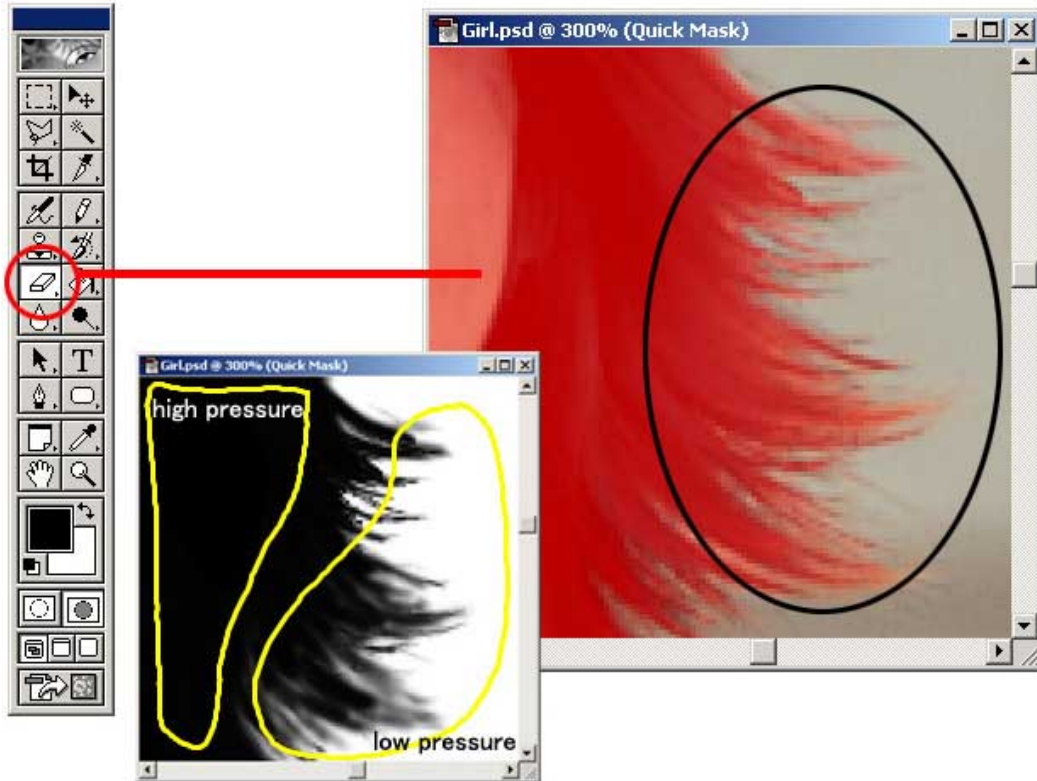
### one-point advice

By setting the pressure sensitivity, you can adjust the brush size or the transparency of the image.



- Apply the mask to the hair area and other fine areas using subtle adjustments to the pressure sensitivity. When dealing with minute details, you can increase the screen scale to make work easier.

If you will take a mistake, use the eraser tool to erase a mask.
